Title of Report	Defibrillator Update February 2019
Summary	<p>Following up on communication with Theresa regarding eligibility for SSE grant.</p> <p>I have spoken with SSE. Because Bloxham is served by Western Power, we are not eligible to apply for a grant from the SSE Resilient Communities Fund.</p> <p>Have followed up with Western Power, unlike SSE they are not a supplier, only a distributor and as such only have a small Community support budget (for our Oxfordshire area only £4K). What they tend to do is make up shortfalls in generating funds rather than 100% funding. I therefore don't think this is an option and we should self fund.</p> <p>Proposal to site the defibrillator on the Ex Servicemans Hall front facing wall to be presented to the Trustees Monday 18th March.</p>
Recommendation	<p>Self fund purchase and installation costs.</p> <p>Purchase model Ipad SP1</p>
Reasons for the Recommendation	<p>Limited option for funding from Western Power.</p> <p>Model recommended by a First responder.</p> <p>Location of ex Servicemans Hall is a central village location.</p>
Impact on Budget	<p>£2k - £2.5K approx (purchase and installation costs)</p> <p>Ongoing maintenance costs:</p> <p>Pad life – 30-36 months, replacement cost £35 approx</p> <p>Battery life 5 years approx, replacement cost £156 approx.</p>
