Title of Report	Bloxham Neighbourhood Development Plan (BNDP) Web Site
Summary	To discuss the future of the BNDP web site.
Recommendation	To keep the BNDP web site and renew the domain name and hosting.
Reasons for the Recommendation	It will create a lot of work to move all the information across from the BNDP web site to the PC web site and for £17 per year, this probably isn't cost effective.
Impact on Budget	None if the BNDP information is stored on the Parish Council web site. £17 per annum if the BNDP web site is kept.
Risks	Information could be lost or less accessible if it is moved across to the PC web site.
Background	<p>Nothing has been added to the site for around 2 years and the site is not smart-phone friendly.</p> <p>It's had around 28,000 views since it was set up but ongoing viewing is down to next to nothing.</p> <p>Although Bloxham St Mary's Church are using it in to inform their proposed church revamp so need to warn them if it's closing.</p> <p>The site hosting and domain run out on 21 March 2019.</p> <p>The downside to the BNDP site is that because it is 'cheap & cheerful' hosting renewal can only be done online via John Groves as an online email of payment.</p> <p>The up-side is it only costs £19.99 for 2 years hosting and £6.99/year for domain registration.</p> <p>John Groves has no view either way about it staying or going but if the PC wants to keep it awhile, they need to budget for the above and let John know before March 21</p>

	<p>John is not sure that transferring everything would be a very 'time-effective' or cost-effective activity.</p> <p>What could be done is to create on the PC website maybe a small number of pages that offer access to the most useful background info that people will want to access. It would involve copying (and probably tweaking) a few existing pages and then uploading the documents and graphics featured on them and incorporating these into the menu system.</p>
