- Discussions were continuing with the Church with regard to a new burial ground in the village.
- The Parish Council is supportive of EV charging points and discussions would be held with the Jubilee Park Management Committee to investigate this at Jubilee Park.
- Investigations into issues with the foul drainage at Jubilee Hall would be undertaken, in conjunction with Cherwell District Council officers.
- A request for funding of £300 was approved for activities during 'The Big Green Week'.
- A memorial to the Smith Family would be erected in the village, subject to permission from the relevant land owner.
- Works to a number of trees would be carried out in the village, by Cotefield Treecare Ltd.
- The Parish Council would again be assisting with the Remembrance Sunday Parade, in consultation with the Royal British Legion and Tom Smith.
- The new Bus Shelter on the A361 would be erected on 16 August 2022.
- A quote had been requested from Field and Lawn for the Christmas lights for 2022.
- Cherwell District Council officers had tried to remove some offensive graffiti from the swings at Jubilee Park, but was unable to completely remove it. Alternative options would be discussed with the Jubilee Park Management Committee.
- The ivy had been cut back along the footpath from Queen Street to Greenhills Park.
